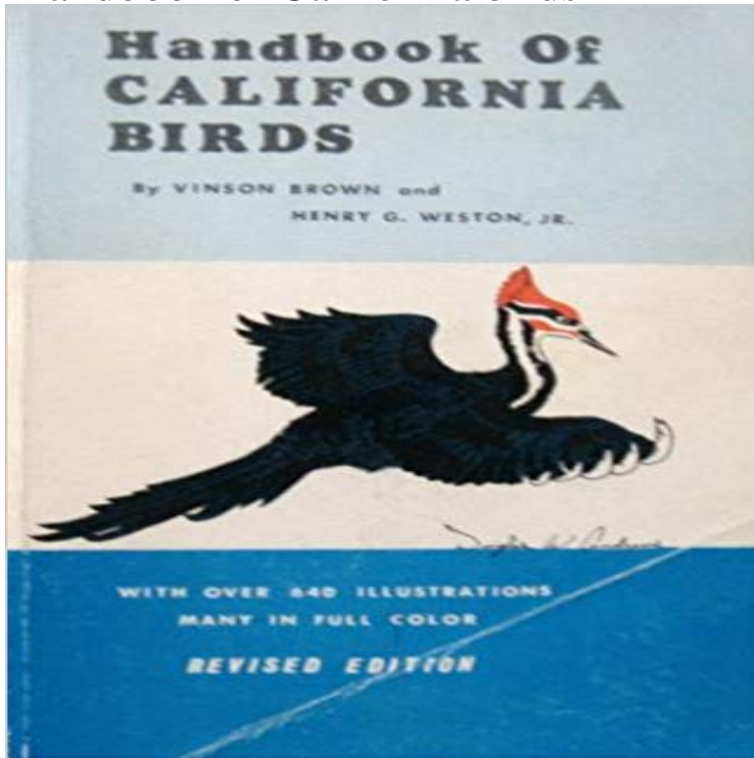


Handbook of California birds
