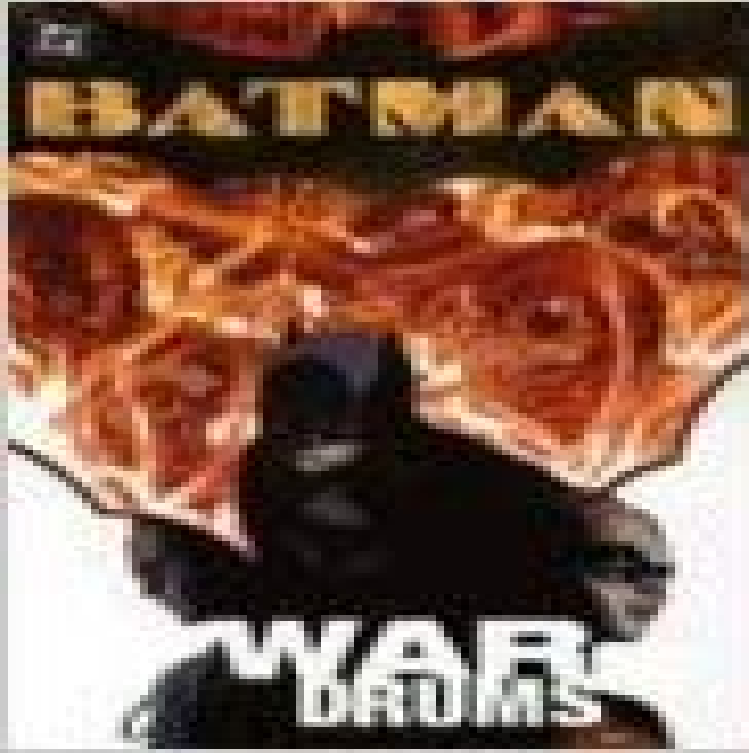


Batman: War Drums (Prelude to War Games)
