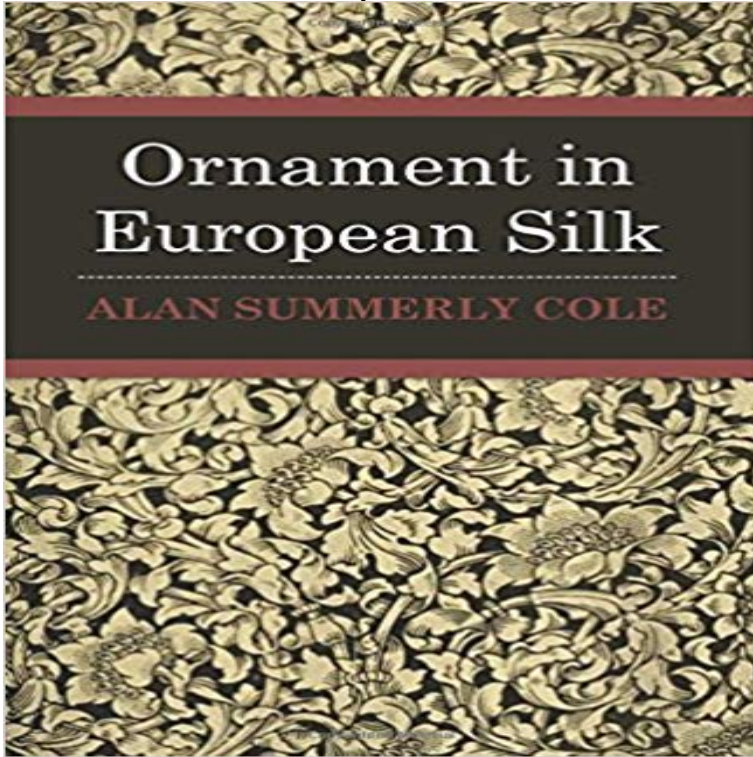


Ornament in European Silks
