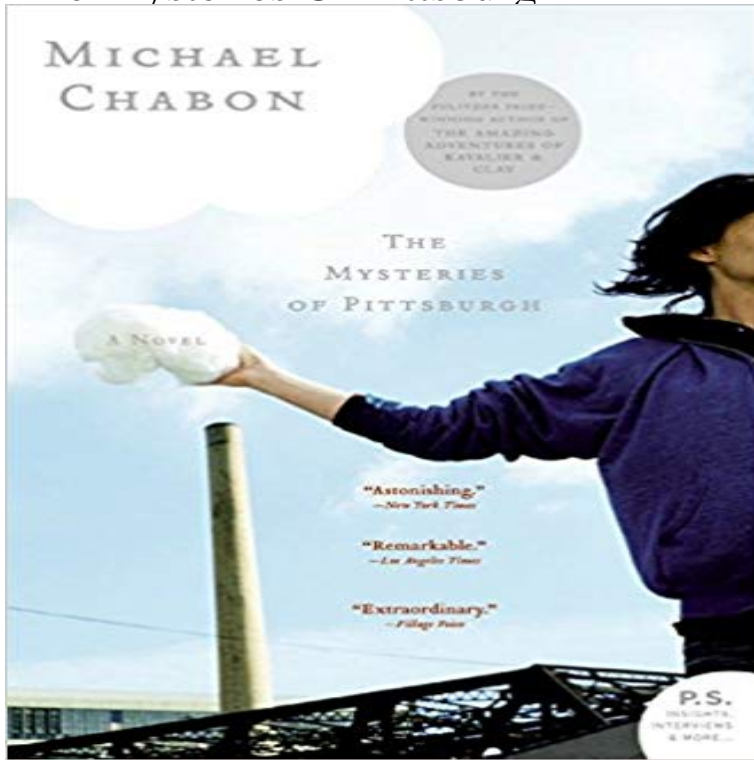


The Mysteries Of Pittsburgh
